<p>Working within the Richmond Hill Youth Hub; a one-stop, full service centre for at-risk youth; the Dishwasher and Kitchen Helper will assist the Food Services Coordinator and Cook in the daily clean-up of Kitchen and eating area as well as assist in preparation of basic ingredients for cooking.</p> <p>Direct responsibilities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash and disinfect dishes and kitchen area including tables, stove tops, shelves, tools, knives, and equipment to ensure sanitary conditions and meet the departmental standards, including using sanitizers required by health department. • Set-up and break down of work station(s). • Prepare basic ingredients for cooking, including portioning, chopping, and storing food before use. • Ensure quality and presentation standards while maintaining a clean and sanitary work environment. • Follow appropriate personal hygiene procedures to ensure food served to youth is safe for consumption, including disinfecting hands prior to handling food and wearing a hat/hairnet and proper footwear. • Follow and ensure compliance with food and safety and handling policies and procedures. • In coordination with Food Services staff, serve food to the youth. • Interact with staff and youth at the HUB, be a positive role model and promote a positive environment. • Ensure items in pantry and fridge are properly labelled and stored. • Sort and put away donations and supplies. • Ensure that kitchen towels/rags and aprons are kept clean and do laundry when needed. • Other duties as assigned.
